

SUPPORT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE MOUTERE HILLS COMMUNITY PATHWAY

The Moutere Hills Residents Association is actively endorsing and representing requests from the community to improve a significant shortcoming in the local infrastructure; the lack of any safe walking or cycling connection between the two main centres of activity, namely:

- 1) The Upper Moutere Village, that includes the primary school, church, shops, petrol station and residences.
- 2) The Moutere Hills Community Centre, Tennis Courts and Domain - the single location where almost all sporting, recreational and social events take place every day of the week.

These two hubs are separated by a distance of less than two kilometres, yet driving between the two is currently the only safe means of travel.

The provision of a suitable pathway from the Upper Moutere Village to the Domain is a small infrastructural project that would bring considerable and popular benefits to the community. These include, but are not limited to:

- Allowing residents, including school children and the elderly, healthy and safe carless access to the Community Centre facilities, Tennis Courts and Sports Fields;
- Enabling local children north of the village to cycle or walk to and from school; the school bus is only available to them at extra charge;
- Providing residents and visitors with a much needed recreational pathway leading from the village;
- Adding value to the existing Community facilities and businesses by enhancing public access and usage.
